## **Materials:**

*When using the suggested materials, it will be about 20 cm tall.*

*The listed wool and hook sizes are only suggestions. It is, of course, entirely your personal choice, which yarn you use.*

*Please keep in mind that different yarn may result in a bigger or smaller piece. Make sure to adapt your hook size according to your yarn and personal tension. When crocheting Amigurumis you should use a much smaller needle size than indicated on the label or you would use it for other crochet projects so that no holes are made when the piece is stuffed.*

- Wool (Sport Weight), e. g. Schachenmayr Catania/Scheepjes Catona, No. 263 (or 255), 247, 254, 257
- Wool for the hair, e. g. Schachenmayr Bravo (No. 8200)
- Crochet hook in suitable size (with me: 2.0 mm)
- Stuffing
- Eyes in suitable size (with me: 10 mm) - you can also crochet or embroider the eyes
- optional: some pipe cleaner

## **Abbreviations (US Terms):**

MR = magic ring	inc = increase
sc = single crochet	dec = decrease

*Crochet in continuous rounds (spirals), unless otherwise stated.*

## **Head:**

*Skin color*

1. sc 6 in MR (6)
2. inc x6 (12)
3. (sc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (sc 2, inc) x6 (24)
5. (sc 3, inc) x6 (30)
6. (sc 4, inc) x6 (36)
7. (sc 5, inc) x6 (42)
8. (sc 6, inc) x6 (48)
- 9.-18. (10 Rounds) sc in each st around (48)
19. (sc 6, dec) x6 (42)
20. (sc 5, dec) x6 (36)
21. (sc 4, dec) x6 (30)
22. (sc 3, dec) x6 (24)
23. (sc 2, dec) x6 (18)
24. (sc 1, dec) x6 (12)
25. dec x6 (6)

*Fasten off, weave in loose ends.*

*Pin the spots for eyes and nose.*

*To shape the eye sockets, thread a sturdy thread through a sufficiently long needle, insert from the bottom and come out at the first eye pin, reinsert a stitch offset, go back down, pull until the eye sockets have formed, knot it well. Repeat for the second eye. Now attach the eyes.*





*Of course you can also simply attach the eyes without sculpting the head.  
For the nose use a length of skin colored thread, insert it from the bottom to the nose pin and whip stitch until a sweet little nose is formed, go back to the starting point and knot well.  
Finally, embroider a mouth, eyelashes and eyebrows and if necessary (e.g. with chalk pastels) make up the cheeks.*



*Mark the hairline with pins (if necessary). Now you can latch hook the hair (I'm using my crochet hook for this). Look at my page (<https://zhaya.de/knothair.html>) for how to attaching the hair.*



# Crochet an oval

## Foot / Leg (make 2):

*Brown*

*You will start with an oval (see the diagram).*

1. ch 6, starting in 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook: sc 4, sc 3 in last st, rotate 180 degrees and crochet along the opposite side of the foundation chain: sc 3, sc 2 in last st (12)
2. inc, sc 3, inc x3, sc 3, inc x2 (18)
3. sc 1, inc, sc 3, (sc 1, inc) x3, sc 3, (sc 1, inc) x2 (24)
4. **BLO**: sc in each st around (24)
- 5.-6. (2 Rounds) sc in each st around (24)
7. sc 7, dec x4, sc 9 (20)
8. sc 7, dec x2, sc 9 (18)
9. sc 6, dec x2, sc 6, dec (15)
- 10.-15. (6 Rounds) sc in each st around (15)
- 16.a) **FLO**: slst 1, ch 1, hdc in same st, hdc 5, dc 5, hdc 4, join round with a slst in 1<sup>st</sup> st.

*Color change to beige.*

- 16.b) **BLO**: sc in each st around (15)
- 17.-23. (7 Rounds) sc in each st around (15)

*Fasten off the first leg, weave in loose ends, do not fasten off the second leg. Now the legs are connected and it starts the:*

## Body:

24. sc until the middle (see picture - with me: sc 5), slst 1, ch 3, slst in the other leg, ch 1 < - tighten this chain, sc 1 in same st, sc 14 around the leg, sc 3 along the chain, sc 1 in the slst, sc 14 around the leg, sc 3 along the chain (36)
- 25.-28. (4 Rounds) sc in each st around (36)
29. sc 7, dec, sc 16, dec, sc 9 (34)
30. sc 7, dec, sc 15, dec, sc 8 (32)

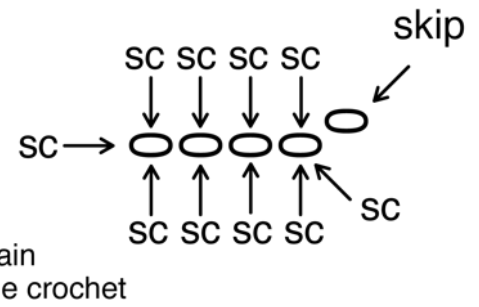
*Stuff and shape the feet.*

*Color change to blue.*

31. sc in each st around (32)
32. sc 6, dec, sc 15, dec, sc 7 (30)
33. **BLO**: sc in each st around (30)
34. sc in each st around (30)
35. (sc 3, dec) x6 (24)
- 36.-38. (3 Rounds) sc in each st around (24)
39. **BLO**: sc in each st around (24)

*Color change to skin color.*

40. sc 5, dec, sc 10, dec, sc 5 (22)
41. sc in each st around (22)
42. sc 4, dec, sc 10, dec, sc 4 (20)
43. sc in each st around (20)
44. sc 4, dec, sc 8, dec, sc 4 (18)
45. sc in each st around (18)
46. (sc 2, dec) x6 (12)
47. sc in each st around (12)



*Stuff and shape the head.*

*For the top rejoin in one of the free loops of round 39 with color of the dress, the feet point to you.*

*Crochet in joined rounds (join each round with a slst and chain 1).*

**39.b) FLO:** sc in each st around, ch 1, turn (24)

**40.b)** sc 5, dec, sc 10, dec, sc 5, ch 1, turn (22)

**41.b)** sc in each st around, ch 1, turn (22)

**42.b)** sc 8, skip 1, dc 5 in 1 st, skip 1, slst 1, skip 1, dc 5 in 1 st, skip 1, sc 7

*Fasten off, weave in loose ends.*



## Skirt:

*Same color as the dress.*

*I used a bigger hook here (with me 3.0 mm)*

*Rejoin in one of the free loops of round 33, the head (or rather the neck) points to you.*

*Crochet in rows. At the end of each row, chain 1 and turn.*

**1. FLO:** dc 2 in each st around, ch 1, turn (33)

**2.** (dc 10, inc) x3 (36)

**3.-6.** (4 Rows) dc in each st around (36)

**7.** (skip 1, dc 1) x3, dc 24, (skip 1, dec 1) x3 (30)

*Fasten off, weave in loose ends. Rejoin at the place shown at the picture to the left and sc around the whole skirt.*

## Hand / Arm (make 2):

*Skin color*

**1.** sc 6 in MR (6)

**2.** inc x6 (12)

**3.-5.** (3 Rounds) sc in each st around (12)

**6.** (sc 2, dec) x3 (9)

*Stuff very loosely or bend some pipe cleaner (see photo) and put it in the hand.*

**7.** (sc 1, dec) x3 (6)

**8.** sc in each st around (6)

**9.** (sc 1, inc) x3 (9)

**10.-20.** (11 Rounds) sc in each st around (9)

*Fasten off, stuff and shape the arm, close it.*





*If not already done, sew the head to the body (preferably with the mattress stitch).  
Attach arms directly under the head.*
